

What is Akkusative?

Akkusative is an object formation within a sentence. Whenever there is a question of whom/ what, it will reflect the need of an object.

Ich kaufe das Auto. {I buy the car.} (Who ist buying the car. The answer is "I" which means "I" is the doer"Subject". "kaufen" is the action. What is being purchased, the answer is "car", hence the car is the object.)

In Akkusative case the Artikel "Der" will become "Den" which I depended on Maskuline.

- Den Mann (Maskuline) [Der Mann]
- Die Frau (feminine)
- Das Kind (Neutral)

Ich kaufe den Kuli. {I buy the Pen.}

Ich esse die Pizza. {I eat the pizza.}

Ich kaufe das Auto. {I buy the car.}

How to differentiate between Nominativ and Akkusativ?

Nominativ	Akkusativ
Der Mann isst. (the man is eating.)	Der Mann isst <b>den Hamburger</b> . (the man is eating the Hamburger.)
Die Frau fährt. (the woman is driving.)	Die Frau fährt <b>das Auto</b> . (the woman is driving the car.)
Das Kind fragt. (the child is asking)	Das Kind fragt die Lehrerin. (the child is asking the teacher)
Ich wasche. (I am washing.)	Ich wasche die Kleider. (I am washing the clothes)
Du schreibst. (you are writing.)	Du schreibst den Brief. (you are writing the Letter.)
